6. **STATUS REPORT- RECOVERY OF AMOUNT IN RESPECT OF CONTRACT OF COLLECTION FEES AND BROKERAGE FROM VENDORS AT WEEKLY MARKET FOR THE PERIOD 2014-15.**

To consider the progress made in the court proceedings regarding recovery of amount in respect of contract of collection of fees and brokerage from vendors at weekly market for the period 2014-15.

As per legal opinion received from Legal Advisor of Cantonment Board, this office has filed independent execution before Hon'ble Civil Judge (S.D) Aurangabad on 07.12.2021 and appointed Adv. Sachin Solanke for search report of properties belonging to agency.

At present this office has received warrant of attachment for movable property in execution of a Decree Holder from Civil Court Senior Division Aurangabad in SCS No. 10/2016 dated July 25th, 2025. The date of hearing of case is scheduled on **June 20th, 2026.**

7. **IMPLEMENTATION OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT (SWM) RULES, 2026 AND CIRCULATION OF THE SAME FOR PUBLIC AWARENESS THROUGH NEWSPAPER PUBLICATION, UPLOADING ON THE OFFICIAL WEBSITE AND ECHHAWANI PORTAL.**

With reference to Government of India, Ministry of Defence, Directorate General Defence Estates, Delhi Cantt. Letter no. 76/38/Rules/MSW Rules/C/DE/17/VOL.IV/2024 dated 22/05/2026, it is intimated that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) has notified the Solid Waste Management (SWM) Rules, 2026 on 27/01/2026 under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. The said Rules has come into force w.e.f. 01/04/2026, in supersession of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, with an objective to ensure environmentally sound management of Solid waste throughout the country.

The newly notified SWM Rules, 2026 prescribe responsibilities for waste generators, local bodies, bulk waste generators, commercial establishments, institutions, market areas and other stakeholders regarding segregation, collection, transportation, processing and scientific disposal of solid waste. The Rules further emphasize reduction of waste generation, source segregation, recycling, composting, scientific landfill management and prohibition of littering and open burning of waste.

In order to ensure effective implementation of the SWM Rules, 2026 within the jurisdiction of Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar Cantonment Board and to create awareness among residents, commercial establishments and institutions regarding their duties and responsibilities under the said Rules, the Rules are required to be circulated widely for information, awareness and strict compliance by all concerned.

Further, for effective public outreach and awareness, it is proposed that:

1. The salient features and important provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026 be published in local newspapers for public awareness and information.

2. The complete notification/circular of the SWM Rules, 2026 be uploaded on the official website & eChhawani portal of the Cantonment Board for easy public access and reference.
3. Necessary awareness activities through notices, public announcements, display boards, social media platforms and other IEC activities be undertaken as and when required.

The relevant documents in this regard are placed on the table. The Board to consider and resolve accordingly.

7. **The Board approved for implementing the Solid Waste Management (SWM) Rules, 2026 in Chh. Sambhajinagar Cantonment Board. President Cantonment Board instructed that a detailed action plan be prepared and put up before Board for approval in ensuing Board meeting.**

8. **EXTENSION OF TENDER FOR CARRYING OUT INFORMATION, EDUCATION & COMMUNICATION (IEC) ACTIVITIES.**

With reference to the existing tender for carrying out various Information, Education & Communication (IEC) activities in Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar Cantonment Board, it is submitted that the said tender expired on **30/04/2026**.

Further, it is pertinent to mention that **Swachh Survekshan Assessment 2026** activities were being conducted during the months of **April- May 2026** in Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar Cantonment. Owing to the intensive preparations, field activities, documentation, public awareness campaigns, and assessment-related engagements associated with Swachh Survekshan, the process for inviting and finalizing a fresh tender for IEC activities could not be completed within the stipulated time, resulting in a delay in the extension/finalization process of the said tender.

It is also submitted that the GFC and ODF Survey may commence in the Cantonment area at any time. IEC activities play a crucial role in public awareness, citizen participation, behavioural change communication, and effective implementation of sanitation initiatives during this period.

In view of the above and to ensure continuity of IEC activities without any interruption, it is proposed to grant an extension to the existing agency **for the aforesaid work as per work order dated 30/04/2025, for the period** of two (02) months or until the finalization of a new tender, whichever is earlier, on the same terms and conditions.

9. **REQUIREMENT OF ADDITIONAL 12 LABOURS FOR DAY/ NIGHT SANITATION ARRANGEMENTS FOR EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF ODF, ODF++ & GFC - 2026 ASSESSMENT.**

As ODF, ODF++ & GFC - 2026 assessment is scheduled to be conducted during June - July 2026, the new ODF, ODF++ & GFC (Garbage free city) - 2026 assessment indicators place special emphasis on critical sanitation parameters such as visible cleanliness, source-level waste segregation, door-to-door collection and transportation, waste processing, and faecal sludge management, **open Defecation**

Free), Garbage Vulnerable Point (GVP) Free, and Clean Toilet Unit (CTU) Free within the Cantonment area.

The assessment framework accords significant weightage to sustained cleanliness of public spaces, prevention of open defecation and littering, elimination of garbage vulnerable points, proper upkeep of public and community toilets, and maintenance of high sanitation standards in commercial areas. Accordingly, it is necessary to further strengthen sanitation arrangements by undertaking **twice-daily sweeping in commercial areas, ensuring regular cleaning and maintenance of public toilets and community toilets**, and carrying out intensive sanitation measures to convert and maintain all identified **GVPs and CTUs into Garbage Free Spots**.

Therefore, the sanitation section proposes the engagement of 12 additional Safaiwala labourers for Day/ night cleaning/Sweeping work, along with an additional round of door-to-door garbage collection during night hours in commercial areas, including deployment of required helpers, from the ongoing Civil Conservancy Tender. The arrangement shall be for a period of 02 months or until finalization of ODF, ODF++ & GFC – 2026 assessment, whichever is earlier, strictly as per tender conditions and prevailing norms.
